I do hereby Certify That John wilson Enlisted as a Soldier in the 1st Virginia Regiment The 12th of
February 1777 and that he served five years as a Soldier, having reinlested for three years after his first
Term of two years was out and that he was discharg'd from the Army
December 13th 1783 C. Minnis Ca't. 1st VR [Calohill Minnis BLWt1507-300]

These are to certify all whom it may concern, that John Philips is hereby empower'd to settle my discharge
for the term which I serv'd in the Army in the 1st Virginia Regiment. Given under my Hand the 11th
December 1783.
