These are to Certify that the bearer hereof Benjamin Wood a Soldier in the first Virginia Regiment, having faithfully served the United States from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 178[?] and being inlisted for the War is hereby discharged from the American army.

Given at the War Office the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August 1783
