I do hereby Certify that John Wright was enlisted by myself as a Soldier in the Revolutionary army in Jan'y 1776 for Dureing the war with Great Britain, and I know he got killed in the Battle at Germantown [4 Oct 1777], Given under my hand this Sixth day April 1808

Sam'l. Arnold 2<sup>d</sup> Lieut. [Samuel Arnold VAS722]
