This is to certify that Moses Wright formerly a Soldier in the 6th Virginia Regiment duly and faithfully served the term of Three years for which was enlisted of which he is hereby discharged from any further service in the army of the United States and permitted to return to his home free & unmolested [unmolested] having received all his Bounty pay Clothing and Deficiency [deficiency] of pay Clothing in full of all accounts & provisions made by the Congress for the troops his receipt for which is on the Back his given under my hand at Philadelphia 31 Day of January 1780 Christian Febiger [VAS675]
