Dragoons] March 27th 1781 & sirvd until the mutiny May 1783
Wm Barret [William Barret VAS1197] f[ormer]ly Capt
Baylor [George Baylor W5966] Dragoons
April 15th 85

NOTE: In May 1783 after the cessation of hostilities in Charleston, South Carolina, some Virginia
cavalrymen departed for home on military horses rather than wait for transport by sea.
