Virginia Bounty-Land Application of George Custard VAS678

Washgton Cot'y. Dec'r. 17th 1784

Sir Please to settle my acc't. of Depretiacion with Lt. Jno. Tannehill [John Tannehill] and deliver him my Certificate In's.[?] & Land Warrant and you'll oblidge yours/ George Custerd  
To the Auditors of public acc'ts for State of Virginia  
Copy/ Markes Vandewall

I do Certify that George Custard a Soldier in Col. John Gibsons 7th Virg'a. Regim't was Inlisted for three year and that he faithfully served the term of his Inlistment he was Inlisted the 25th Dec'r 1776 & was discharg'd March 5<sup>th</sup> 1780 Given under my hand at Pittsb'g Aug't. 6,1784
