Washgton Cot'y. Dec'r. 17th 1784

Sir Please to settle my acc't. of Depretiacion with Lt. Jonah Tannehill [Jonah Tannehill] and deliver him my Certificate In's.[?] & Land Warrant and youll oblidge yours/ John Custerd
To the Auditors of public acc'ts for State of Virginia
Copy/ Markes Vandewall

I do Certify that John Custard a Soldier in Col. John Gibsons 7th Va. Reg't was Inlisted for three year and that he faithfully serv'd the term of his Inlistment he was Inlisted the 25th Dec'r 1776 and was discharg'd March 1st 1780 Given under my hand at Fort Pitt Aug't. 6th 1784
