The bearer William Davies a Soldier belonging to the Legion Infantry of State troops having serv'd during the war with Great Britain the term of which he was inlisted for is hereby Discharg'd, in which we Certify that he has behav'd as a Brave & faithfull Soldier —

Given under our hand at york this 22<sup>d</sup> of April  
1783, in the seventh year of the Common Wealth
