Virginia Bounty-Land Application of Christian Charles De Klauman VAS827

In the House of Delegates

Saturday 22^d day of May 1784.

Resolved that the petition of Christian Charles De Klauman praying such a Bounty in Lands for his services in the Army may entitle him to is reasonable, and that he be allowed the same Bounty in Lands as is by Law given to a Major.
