[Methodology: Spelling, punctuation and/or grammar have been corrected in some instances for ease of reading and to facilitate searches of the database. Where the meaning is not compromised by adhering to the spelling, punctuation or grammar, no change has been made. Corrections or additional notes have been inserted within brackets or footnotes. Blanks appearing in the transcripts reflect blanks in the original. A bracketed question mark indicates that the word or words preceding it represent(s) a guess by me. The word 'illegible' or 'indecipherable' appearing in brackets indicates that at the time I made the transcription, I was unable to decipher the word or phrase in question. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]



This may Certify that Samuel Lucas fife major in the 2 State Regiment Enlisted March 25 1777 and has served during the war and is hereby Discharged.

Given under my hand this 25th day of April 1783

A handwritten certificate in cursive script. The text reads: "This may Certify that Samuel Lucas fife major in the 2 State Regiment Enlisted March 25 1777 & has served during the war and is hereby Discharged. Given Under My hand this 25 day of April 1783". Below the text is a signature that appears to be "Ab. Crump Capt." and another signature below that, possibly "W. Graves".

This MAY or MAY NOT relate to the same man named Samuel Lucas

At a Court held for James City County September 11th, 1780

A Certificate from Colonel William Brent of Samuel Lucas having served three years as a Soldier in the Second Virginia State [Troops] and another Certificate from Robert Andrews a Justice of the said County of the said Lucas having made oath before him of his [indecipherable word] proving or claiming his Right to Land for the Service aforesaid was produced & red & ordered to be certified [indecipherable word]
