PAYROLL OF CAPT. AMBROSE MADISON'S COMPANY IN COL. FRANCIS TAYLOR'S CONVENTION ARMY GUARD REGIMENT AT ALBEMARLE BARRACKS, VIRGINIA, APRIL AND MAY 1779

["Convention Army" refers to Gen. John Burgoyne's soldiers, mainly Hessians, captured at Saratoga on 17 Oct 1777 and kept at Albemarle Barracks 5 mi NW of Charlottesville VA from Jan 1779 through Feb 1781. Many of these soldiers are also on the payroll of the company of James Burton (<http://revwarapps.org/b112.pdf>), who became captain after the resignation of Madison. Numbers in brackets are pension applications.]

I do hereby certify, that the within Roll of Capt. Ambrose Madison was found among the papers of my dec'd Father, Hudson Martin [W7394] – pay-master to the Albemarle Barracks – Regt from 1779 to 1781 – which papers have been placed in the hands of Robt H Gray of Lynch'g.


