MUSTER AND PAY ROLLS OF THE COMPANY OF CAPT. JOHN SYME OF THE 10TH VIRGINIA CONTINENTAL REGIMENT, MAY 1777 THROUGH AUGUST 1778

Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris. Revised 24 Nov 2018.

[According to E. M. Sanchez-Saavedra, *A Guide to Virginia Military Organizations in the American Revolution, 1774-1787* (Westminster MD: Heritage Books, 2007, p. 62), "The 10th Virginia Regiment was one of the six new regiments ordered raised by the General Assembly in October 1776 to meet Virginia's quota of fifteen regiments set by Congress on September 16, 1776." Capt. John Syme's company number 8 from Augusta County was completed on 3 Dec. 1776, marched northward with the other nine companies of the regiment in the spring of 1777, and joined Washington's main army at Middlebrook NJ in June 1777.

The rolls transcribed here cover the period from the formation of the company until the number of regiments was reduced at White Plains NY on 14 Aug 1778, and the 10th became the 6th Virginia Regiment. These rosters document attrition from sickness, desertion, casualties at the battles of Brandywine (11 Sep. 1777) and Germantown (4 Oct. 1777), and from the winter encampment at Valley Forge (19 Dec 1777 - 19 June 1778). During this period the number of Privates in the company fell from 64 to 29.

These rolls are transcribed from Fold3.com beginning with image <https://www.fold3.com/image/9098592> and reordered chronologically. A copy of the muster roll for September 1777 is in the [bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia](#) for Charles Cameron S6624 and was previously transcribed by Will Graves.

The likely full name of the soldier and the number of any pension or bounty-land application are given in brackets where the name first occurs. Note that many of the names are spelled in a variety of ways. **P** means "Promoted," and **R** means "Reduced in rank."

A copy of the first payroll can also be found in the [bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia](#) for Charles Cameron S6624. The original had 17 columns, but the following have been omitted or combined here:

4 & 5: "time of Service" in Months and Days, combined

9, 10, & 11: "Whole pay £ S D", combined

12: "No. Dollars for whole pay," blank in original; omitted

13, 14, & 15: "Whole Subsistence £ S D", combined

16: "No. Dollars for Subsistence," blank in original; omitted
