

Redstone Fort was on the Monongahela River at present Brownsville in the part of Pennsylvania then claimed by Virginia.

Merged with this file in Fold3.com is "A pay Roll of Capt. Conkey Company of Rangers Raised in the County of Charralotte and Now Doing duty to January the 3th 1776." Notes in the file state that this company was from Charlotte County VA. In fact however, Joshua Conkey's company was from Charlotte County in the state of New York, renamed Washington County in 1784.
