

David Shepherd

County Lut [see endnote]

A handwritten signature in cursive script that reads "David Shepherd". The signature is written in dark ink on a light-colored, slightly textured paper. The letters are fluid and connected, with a prominent flourish at the end of the word "Shepherd".

NOTE: David Shepherd was the County Lieutenant and therefore in charge of Militia. He may have made this list to keep track of which men were exempt from being drafted into militia service because they were in the Continental Army.
