The original table is in 28 columns on one sheet. In this transcription from <http://www.fold3.com/image/#24619946960> the table is divided, and the rows have been numbered.

Parts of Ohio and Monongalia counties, and almost all of Yohogania County, were determined by survey in the 1780s to be in Pennsylvania rather than Virginia. The remains of Ohio and Monongalia counties are now in West Virginia. The part of Yohogania County determined to be in PA was later divided into present Westmoreland County and parts of Allegheny, Beaver, Washington, and Fayette counties.

The locations of the forts are as follows:

Fort Henry: On present Main St in Wheeling, Ohio County WV.

Fort Shepherd: On Shepherd College campus in Shepherdstown, Jefferson County WV.

Fort Vanmeter: Near present Clinton in Ohio County WV.

Reardon's Bottom: Near present Georgetown in Beaver County PA.

Holladays Cove: In present Hollidays Cove, Hancock County WV.

Montours Bottom: Near present Coraopolis, Allegheny County PA.

Redstone Fort: At present Brownsville, Fayette County PA.

Fort Martin: On Crooked Run 4 mi NE of present Madsville in Monongalia County WV.

Fort Kerns: On present Dewey St in Morgantown, Monongalia County WV.

Fort Jackson: On Tenmile Creek at present Waynesburg in Greene County PA.]

Fort Gerrard: At Fort Garard now in Greene County PA.

Fort Pricket: Now Pricketts Fort State Park in Marion County WV.
