Sanchez-Saavedra (*A Guide to Virginia Military Organizations in the American Revolution, 1774-1787*. Westminster MD: Heritage Books. 2007), Michaux's company, number 10 in the 14<sup>th</sup> Virginia Continental Regiment, was raised in Charlotte County in Feb 1777.

Brackets enclose full or alternative spellings of names, as well as the numbers of pension applications.

The first item is undated but presumed to be from 1777. During filming this document was divided onto two frames, pp 42,43 of the online file.]
