I Certify that the within is an exact copy of the Return of the officers of the Georgia Line of the Army that I made to the Honorable Major General Lincoln [Benjamin Lincoln] Secretary of War, upon his request to be furnished with the names of such Officers as were Entitled to promotion by the Act of Congress 30th September 1783, in order to enable him to fill up and send their new Commissions to them.
