

Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

AMERICAN OFFICERS IMPRISONED AT NEW YORK CITY AND LONG ISLAND NY
1776 – 1780

Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

On 21 Aug 1832 Hezekiah Davies applied for a pension (S2161) for his service as a Lieutenant in the Flying Camp from Pennsylvania. As proof of his service he submitted a record he had made of his fellow prisoners of war, which he described as follows:

“From Fort Lee the troops of the Flying Camp, including the Regiment to which the applicant belonged crossed over the Hudson river to Fort Washington on York Island. On the 16th of November 1776, the troops at Fort Washington, including not only those of the Flying Camp, but also the fifth Continental Regiment of the Pennsylvania line, and troops from other States, the whole being under the Command of Colonel [Robert] Magaw of the 5th Penns’ a. Regiment were attacked by the British forces and after an engagement with the Enemy from early in the morning until late in the afternoon the American troops were surrendered prisoners of war. That your applicant having then become a prisoner to the Enemy, He with his fellow prisoners were marched that evening down to Haarlam [Harlem] and the next day marched into the City of New York then in the possession of the British. That your applicant was for a few weeks confined with others on board a prison ship, and on the 20th of January 1777 was transferred to Long Island until Exchanged on the 7th of December 1780 – during the time of such captivity this applicant with other Officers were held under the following parole, a Copy of which he has preserved ‘We whose names are underwritten pledge on faith and Honors to General Howe, that we will not depart from the house we are placed in, by the Commissary of prisoners, nor go beyond the bounds prescribed by him. And further, that we will not do or say any thing contrary to the interest of his Majesty or his Government.’ [Several lines not transcribed here.] That this applicant while a Prisoner of War, made out a list of all the Prisoners of war detained in New York and Long Island from Official documents, shewing the names of all the Officers whether of the Continental troops, Flying Camp or Militia, shewing their rank, dates of Commission, the Corps to which they belonged, the time when taken, as well as the place where taken, and also of those who died in Captivity.”

The list appears to have been written in a small notebook and is still legible. The exact date of the list is not shown, but it includes the names of officers captured as late as 28 Sep 1780. I have generally not attempted to correct the spellings of names. Davis consistently misspelled the name Henry as “Henery,” the surname of Lt. Col. Moses Rawlings (VAS683) as “Rawlins,” and the surname of Stephen Moylan as “Moyland.”

The following officers and citizens were from the South. Their names as originally spelled are boldfaced on the pages indicated. The file numbers of applications for pension or bounty-land are given in brackets.

NOTE: The numbers in this table do not agree with the numbers on the following pages. “Troops of the convention” refers to British troops captured at Saratoga on 17 Oct 1777 who were to have been returned to England under an agreement (“Convention”) between British Gen. John Burgoyne and American Gen. Horatio Gates, but who were kept as prisoners because of objections by Congress. The numbers of British prisoners in each rank would have been of considerable interest to American prisoners, because one American officer of a particular rank would generally be exchanged for a British officer of the equivalent rank.
