



The number or numbers appearing after a man's name refer to South Carolina Audited Accounts (AA) records in which the example can be found. To find the AA for a specific person, click on the Just take me to the search page link, then enter the person's surname first in the "Full name" box followed by a comma and the person's Christian name. These signatures appear on documents dating during the period from 1775 through 1790, although most date in the 1780's.]
