

Southern Campaigns American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

CULPEPER COUNTY, VIRGINIA, MILITIAMEN DIVIDED INTO CLASSES, JANUARY 1781
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris. B415

INTRODUCTION

As explained in the typed introduction transcribed on the next page, the following list was compiled in response to an act of the October 1780 session of the Virginia legislature to replenish the Virginia Continental Line to satisfy the quota imposed by the Continental Congress. Most of Virginia's Continental troops had been captured at the surrender of Charleston on May 12, 1780, and there were additional losses at the Battle of Waxhaws on the following May 29 and at the Battle of Camden on August 16. Under this "act for recruiting this state's quota of troops to serve in the continental army" (<http://vagenweb.org/hening/vol10-16.htm>) each county was to provide a number of recruits into Continental service by dividing its militia into classes and drawing one man from each class. Perhaps surprisingly, commissioned and noncommissioned officers were included along with privates. One man from each class was chosen by drawing straws or by some other unbiased means. Sometimes a man would volunteer or be paid to satisfy his class's quota, or a man would substitute himself for a brother, a father, or a friend who had been selected. The draftees were to serve 18 months and were therefore often referred to as "eighteen-months men." Some, however, enlisted for the duration of the war and were promised the following bounty: "a healthy sound negro, between the ages of ten and thirty years, or sixty pounds in gold or silver, at the option of the soldier in lieu thereof, to be paid for, or procured by equal assessment on property; and moreover be entitled to three hundred acres of land, in lieu of all such bounties given by any former laws." I am not aware that bounties were ever paid in the form of enslaved people.

Culpeper County's quota was 106 men, so there were 106 classes of 13 or 14 men each. The list of all the men from Culpeper County may be the only one that survives. It now exists as a bound booklet labeled "CULPEPER CLASSES" in the Library of Virginia (accession APA 227, BC 7431696). I am grateful to James Underwood for generously sharing clear photographic images of each page. Underwood also provided me with a copy of a typewritten transcript made by Tennie Selby Burk in 1971, which has been helpful. Ms. Burk's transcription provides information that is not contained in the original document.

As in the original, I have arranged four classes to each page. I have generally retained the original spelling except for "Reuben," which the scribe spelled "Reubin." Full names and alternative spellings are given in brackets, as well as the numbers for any *possible* pension or other records transcribed at revwarapps.org. Many of the soldiers in this list are mentioned in documents by others, so be sure to use the search tool at revwarapps.org for particular names, using variant spellings. As noted, some of the soldiers in the list are described in size roll B81 at <http://revwarapps.org/b81.pdf>.

The title page to the document known as Culpeper Classes reads “A List of the Classes in Culpeper County for January 1781, for Recruiting this states Quota of Troops to serve in the Continental Army.” The “list” is a booklet of 28 pages and there are 106 numbered lists of men—each list has either 13 or 14 names. Out of each list one man is indicated as “a draft”, and in some instances a substitute is given. This gives a total of 106 men drafted; this accords with the tabulation on the title page. An act of the General Assembly passed during the October, 1780 session entitled “An Act for recruiting this state’s quota of troops to serve in the Continental Army” (10 Hening p. 326-337) states that “three thousand able bodied men shall be raised” and the counties “shall furnish within fifty days after their militia shall have laid off into divisions... the following numbers of men... the county of Culpeper one hundred and six men....” The act provided that the county lieutenant or commanding officer should summon the field officers, and the militia was to be divided “including all the commissioned and non-commissioned officers under the age of fifty years, into as many divisions as the number of men required by this act shall make necessary, taking care to number each division....” The officers were to draft an able bodied man, “by fair and impartial lot, out of each division... who may... be permitted to procure a substitute....”

It appears therefore that the “Culpeper Classes” was made pursuant to the above cited act; that the men therein listed belonged to the militia; and that out of this militia which was divided into 106 divisions or classes, 106 men were drafted.
