ⁱ W18643 His pension application is unclear, but he says [does not give the time] "he marched under General Orders to Petersburg Virginia, where Capt. Adam Wallace took the Command of the Company, which Company was attached to the 6th Va. Regiment, Commanded by Col. Bluford which belonged to the brigade Commanded by Genl. Scott; from Petersburg, Va. he marched under Capt. Wallace to Santee River S. Carolina within 65 miles of Charlestown & from there they moved on to the flat Rock where they were defeated; after the said Defeat they moved on to Chesterfield Co:...."
