MUSTER ROLLS FOR COL. THOMAS POSEY'S VIRGINIA BATTALION, JAN 1782 - MAY 1783  
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

[After virtually the entire Virginia Continental Army was captured at Charleston on 12 May 1780, Maj. Thomas Posey (BLWt1733-450) managed to recruit two small battalions by late in 1780. The battalions were to serve in the Carolinas under Gen. Nathanael Greene, but the British invasion of Virginia delayed their march to the South until after the surrender of Cornwallis on 19 Oct 1781. By the time Posey's detachment arrived in the south in the spring of 1782 it comprised two companies from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Virginia Continental Regiment and one company each from the remaining seven Virginia Continental regiments. The only field officer besides Posey was apparently Major Samuel Finley (W10026). The Captains of these nine companies are listed below in the order in which their rolls occur in the present file, followed by the regiments from which they were detached. As the ranks were depleted by expiring enlistments, desertions, and deaths (mainly by disease), companies were consolidated until finally by May 1783 the only one left was that of Capt. Clough Shelton.

Before joining Greene's Southern Army, Posey's detachment joined Gen. Anthony Wayne's Pennsylvania troops at Ebenezer GA, where they helped keep the British bottled up in Savannah. After the British evacuated Savannah on 11 July 1782, Posey's detachment joined Greene at Ashley Hill (just south of Middleton Place Plantation) to help keep the British confined in Charleston SC. The following time line shows some of the major events during the period when the above rosters were made.


- Apr 7 Col. Posey's Battalion joins Gen. Anthony Wayne's Pennsylvania troops at Ebenezer GA
- May 20 Wayne and Posey attacked by Loyalists under Lt Col Thomas Brown at Harris's Bridge, Ogeechee Ferry GA
- May 24 Wayne and Posey attacked by Cherokees at Sharon GA
- June 23 At Ebenezer Wayne and Posey attacked by Loyalists under Creek Chief Emistisiguo
- July 11 Wayne and Posey enter Savannah as British evacuate
- July 15 About this date Posey leaves Savannah to join Greene at Ashley Hill in South Carolina
- Oct late Posey's detachment returning to Virginia
- Dec 14 British evacuate Charleston

Full and alternative spellings of names, as well as the file numbers of pension and bounty-land applications, are added in brackets at the first occurrence of the name. Most names occur on more than one roster, sometimes in more than one company, and often with different spellings. Columns headed "Term of Inlistment" show the time remaining. The original tables have columns headed "Mustered," which are omitted here because they merely repeat the soldiers' names except those indicated by \*. Columns headed "Time since last Mustered, or Inlisted" are omitted because they are either blank or have the same datum for each mustered soldier. In some of the rosters columns headed "Alteration Since Last Muster" are omitted when there are no entries or they add no new information.]
