I John Cropper Junior<sup>1</sup> hereby certify, that the following Soldiers enlisted in the 9<sup>th</sup> Virginia regiment, which regiment was received on Continental Establishment, joined the American Army in the year 1776, and was chiefly taken at the battle of German Town [Germantown], the 4<sup>th</sup> of October 1777



The quality of the digital images of this document is poor. The way it is posted makes it difficult to be absolutely positive that the notations align properly, so there may be some errors in the attribution of the notations to particular veterans. The notations in parenthetical italics are in a different handwriting than the rest of the document. It is my guess that the notations in the parenthetical italics were made by the Register of land warrants in Richmond. All of the other notations appear to be in the same handwriting as the original list of veterans. Also, because of formatting limitations, I was not able to duplicate the manner in which the register of land warrants indicated that no warrant had been issued to particular veterans. That was indicated by large "}" marking groups of many of the veterans' names.]
