<sup>1</sup> Note: The 9<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment was captured when it pushed too far into the British lines & was cut off and captured, over 400 men, almost the whole Regiment at the Battle of Germantown, 4 Oct 1777. A German Jaeger noted in his diary 454 men. The Company of Samuel Woodson, here, has every man captured, except Capt. Woodson, who was recruiting in Virginia and the Drum Major John Beal.

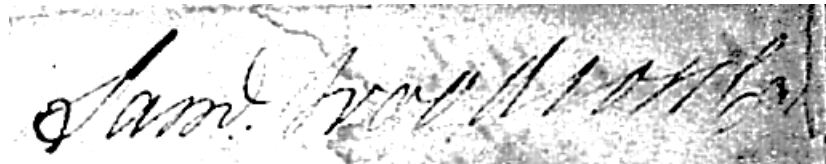
