Bounty Land Warrant of Spencer Cooper BLWt11985-100 VA
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[The federal file jacket indicates that Cooper was a matross (private of artillery), but it contains no original document. The following from the [bounty-warrant papers in the Library of Virginia](#) is assumed to pertain to the same soldier:]

These are to Certify that the bearer hereof Spencer Cooper Corp'l in the first Artillery Regim't, having faithfully served the United States from the 2^d of June 1780 to this date and being enlisted for the War, is hereby discharged from the American army.

Given at the War office the 5th of July 1783 B Lincoln [Gen. Benjamin Lincoln]
