[The federal file contains no original document, but the file number shows that he received a land bounty of 100 acres, which is the amount awarded a Private. This Patrick Daugherty may be the one who also obtained a land bounty from Virginia for service as a Private, as shown in the following from the [bounty-warrant papers in the Library of Virginia](#):]

I do certify that Patrick Daugherty Enlisted in the Virg'a line the 26th of Feb'y. 1776 and has been constant in Service from that time Mar 23<sup>d</sup> 1783    Albert Russel [VAS84] Lt/ 1<sup>st</sup> Virg'a
