form letter in response to an inquiry reads:

"In reply to your letter of this 7th instad, you are advised that a careful search of the records fails to show that a claim for pension was filed on account of the services of Major Joseph Lane of the Georgia Troops, war of the Revolution.

Warrant No. 1325 for four hundred acres of bounty land was issued September 5, 1790 or 1791 on account of his services but there is no further data on file relative to him owing to the disruption of all papers when the War Office was burned in November 1800.

For the location of said land you should apply to the General Land Office, Washington, DC citing all the above data."
