Bounty Land Warrant of Thomas Hill BLWT1429-100

State of Virginia

County of Bedford

I James Hill, brother and one of the heirs at law of Thomas Hill do upon oath testify and declare to the best of my knowledge and belief that Thomas Hill did enlist in 1779 for during the war and served in the Regiment Number Fifteen under the command of Col. Richard Parker of the Virginia Continental line, and that he continued in the service aforesaid until the close of the war. I further declare that I have never received a warrant for the bounty land promised to Thomas Hill on the part of the United States, no do I believe that he ever received it or transfered his claim to above in any manner whatsoever.
