
Bounty Land Warrant of William Davis BLWt1536-100

County of Bedford }

I William Davis aged 74 years do upon oath testify & declare that in the year 1778 I Enlisted for the term of during the war and served in Armands Corps [Charles Armand's Legion of Virginia Forces] under the command of General Armand on continental Establishment and that I continued in the Servis aforesaid until the close of the War when I was Regularly discharged from Armands Corps by General Armond I further declare that I have never received a warrant for the bounty land promised to me on the part of the united States nor have I ever assigned or transfered my claim in any maner whatsoever – [power of attorney to Leroy Jordan of Bedford County follows]
