I, Bennett Hancock aged about seventy four years, do, upon oath, testify and declare, that, in the year one thousand seven hundred and [blank] I enlisted for the term of "during the war," and served in the regiment No. [blank] under the command of Colonel Feebecker [sic: Christian Febiger] of the Virginia line; and that I continued in the service aforesaid until the close of the war, when I was regularly discharged from the same regiment, commanded by Colonel Feebecker

I further declare, that I have never received a warrant for the Bounty Land promised to me on the part of the United States: therefore [power of attorney follows]       [signed] Bennet Hancock
