William Tate of the Artillery this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Six hundred and Sixty nine pounds seven Shillings and Six Pence Sterling for his pay and subsistence to the 1st of January 1782 and for his additional State pay to the 1st of May 1783 per Certificate from the Auditor General.”]



Received October the 23rd 1784 from the Commissioners of the Treasury Three Hundred & Six pounds Eight Shillings by Discount in Consideration money for Six Tracks [sic] of Land Containing three thousand & sixty four Acres above the old Boundary Line
