Winchester Barracks March 25<sup>th</sup> 1783

I do hereby certify that Capt Leut A Bohannon of the First Regm't of Artillery entered the Service in February one thousand seven hundred & seventy six & is still in Actual Service & has been ever since

I do Certify that Ambrose Bohannon Entered into the Seventh Virginia Continental Regiment as a Cadet in the winter of seventeen hundred and seventy five. six, and continued therein till he was appointed an Officer in Colo. Harrisons [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Regiment of Artillery, in which he served untill the Close of the war and Ranked as a Captain Lieutenant

Given under my hand this 19<sup>th</sup> Septemb 1807.
