Bounty Land Warrant of Joseph Conway BLWt461-200

[The file contains no original document. A typed summary states that on 17 Feb 1797 Joseph Conway received a warrant for 200 acres of bounty land for his service at a Lieutenant from Virginia. The [bounty-warrant papers in the Library of Virginia](#) contain the following:]

I do certify that Lieutenant Joseph Conway of the Virginia Line entered the service in Jan'y 1776, and was appointed an Officer in July 1777, and continued in actual service successively ever since without being broke or superceded.
