It appears by a register of the Musters on file in this office that Zedick Tucker Enlisted in the Delaware Regiment on the 22<sup>d</sup> of April 1778 for during the War and is remarked to have been missing in action 16<sup>th</sup> August 1780 [at the Battle of Camden SC].

Guilford County

I do hereby Certify that Levi Tucker had no own Brother but Zadoc Tucker that he was killed in the War between the United States of America & Great Britain, & further that the s'd Levi Tucker administer'd upon his (the said Zadoc Tuckers) property & did draw a Certificate from the Delaware State for his pay Sworn to and subscribe to this 20 day of July 1809
