Bounty Land Claim of Nathaniel Beall BLWt493-100

VA

Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Beall of the County of Ohio in the State of Kentucky do by these presents constitute & appoint Major Hezekiah Rogers of the War office in the City of Washington to be my true & lawful attorney to Ask for demand & receive of the Hon'ble William Eustis Secretary of War for the time being & his successors in Office a land Warrant due me in consideration of my services in the Virginia continetial line to the end of the late War between the United States & Great Britain under the Command of Col. George Baylor of the third Regiment of Cavalry I the said Nathaniel being a trooper in said Regiment Hereby giving my said attorney as full and ample powers... [the rest not transcribed]



This will certify that in the spring of 1779 I inlisted Nathaniel Beall to serve as a trooper in the third troop of the third Regiment of Cavalry commanded by Col George Baylor of the Virginia line, for three years, which he served untill the expiration, & then inlisted during the war in the same Regiment; & during the whole of his service he conducted himself as a good & faithfull soldier receiving sundry wounds both at Stono [Stono Ferry SC, 20 Jun 1779] & Lanew's ferry [Leneud's Ferry SC, 6 May 1780].
