

I do hereby Certify that Major Edmund Dickerson late in the Virginia Continental Line was killed in the Action of Monmouth on the twenty eighth day of June one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight in the exercise of his Office as Major to the first of the first Virginia Regiment

Given under my hand this 27th day of March 1783
