Bounty Land Warrant of Nathaniel Darby BLWt605-200 VA
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[The federal file contains no original document, but a note on the jacket states that on 26 June 1789 Andrew Moore was issued a warrant for 200 acres of land for Darby's service as a Lieutenant. The following are in the [bounty-warrant papers in the Library of Virginia](#):]

Richmond June 27, 1783

I do hereby certify that the bearer hereof Lieutenant Nath'l Darby has served successively from June 1776 in the Virg'a. Cont'l. Line Given under my hand this day above written
John Poulson Maj. 8th Va[?] Regiment

Richmond 23^d Feby 1785

Rec'd. of Cha. Jones two certificates being the full of the Bal[anc]e of Lt. Nath'l. Darby's Claim for pay and commutation No. 79,931. One thousand six hundred Dolls. & 79,930 One hundred & forty six Dollars and sixty Nineteeths. Which I promise to Deliver to Mr. W. Danby. Cha. Stockly
