Pension Application of James Chevalier de Segond: BLWt65-300

Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[In Latin and English and certified in French at Temeswar (Timișoara) in present Romania.]
Know all Men by these Presents, that I, James Chevalier de Segond formerly a Major in Polasky's [sic: Kazimierz Pulaski's] Legion in the Service of the United States during the late war between the said United States and the King of Great Britain have made, ordained, Authorized, Constituted and appointed and by these Presents do make, authorize, ordain, constitute and appoint Herman LeRoy, William Bayard, and James McEvers of the City and State of New York jointly and either of them severally to be my true and lawful Attorneys and Attorney for me and in my Name to ask, demand and receive from the Gouvernement of the United States a Patent or Warrant for any tract or tracts of Land to which I may be entitled for my services as a Major in Polasky's Legion during the said war And I do by these Presents give and grant unto the said Herman Le Roy, William Bayard and James McEvers full power and lawful Authority for me and in my name stead and places to do or cause to be done all and every such Act and Acts, thing and things as shall be requisite on my Behalf to be done in the Premises and that in as full, large and ample Manner as if I myself were at the doing thereof personally present and had done the same hereby ratifying, allowing and confirming all and whatsoever my said Attorneys jointly or separately shall lawfully do in the Premises.
