I do hereby Certify that Lt Colo Thomas Gaskins was appointed an officer in the Virginia Continental Line the 1<sup>st</sup> February one Thousand seven hundred seventy six, and continued in actual service till the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1783 and then retired on half pay for want of a command. Given under my hand at Fredericksburg the 13<sup>th</sup> May 17[?]3
