We the Subscribers acknowledge that we have Voluntarily inlisted our selves into the fourth North Carolina Regiment now in the Service of the United States for & during the term of three years, from the date annexed to our names, & do promise to be subject to the rules & regulations prescribed by the Continental Congress for the Government of the Continental Army, also the orders of Our Superior Officers, set over us by them.
