on the 5<sup>th</sup> august 1834 this man stated that he was then in his 95<sup>th</sup> year of age. Cant tell in what year he was a spy nor can he tell under what officer he did spy — he was an associate Spy with Westfall who is Dead - he was spying about the time the Battle was at Point Pleasant [10 Oct 1774] and previous to that time. - he also done some scouting, but cant tell how much nor in what year —

Note the Battle of Point Pleasant, Dunmores war, was in 1774—
