State of South Carolina, York District

On this 12th day of December 1846 came personally before me Robert Wilson a resident of said District of York District aged 88 years, who being first duly sworn according to law maketh oath that he was well acquainted with the late Joab Trevillian of the aforesaid District whose widow is now applying for a pension for the Revolutionary Services of the deceased husband the aforesaid Joab Trevillian, that he lived in the neighborhood at the time of the marriage of the said Joab Trevillian to the applicant Sarah King now Sarah Trevillian

that they were married about the year 1782 or 3 as well as he recollects and that the said Joab Trevillian and Sarah Trevillian lived together as man and wife for many years and was so considered in law – and had several children the number not none [sic, known] when they moved from this District about the year 1805
