Know all men by these presents that I William Harris of the County and State aforesaid do hereby constitute appoint and fully empower irrevocably William R Query and Henry H. Walker of Stock Hill Georgia my true and lawful Attorneys for me and in my name place and stead to Examine into to demand ask and Receive from the Government Officers of the United States all my Rights in any manner of Claims for Pension Money or Bounty Land that may be due me as Son and Heir John Harris who was a Revolutionary Soldier of the State of South Carolina & who died Leaveing the same undrawn as in Right of law custom or Equity he is or may be entitled as son and Heir of said Revolutionary Soldier hereby Confirming my said Attorneys legal acts in and about the premises

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my name and seal on the 17th day of Febuary A.D. 1854.
