Pension Application of Charles Jones R50

July 27, 1849

I certify that I have examined the claim of the administrator of Charles Jones, dec'd. who was a Lieutenant in the Virginia State Navy during the revolution; and I find that he served until 1781, when he became a supernumerary; and that under the act of the 5 July 1832 there is half-pay due from the 22^d of April 1783 [formal end of the war], until the first of January eighteen hundred and ten, when he died, at the rate of one hundred and eighty two dollars and fifty cents. The amount is payable to Frederick Vincent, Esq. of Philadelphia, attorney of Mr. William Woodward, of Norfolk, Va administrator of said Jones.
