

department as one third disability while in the line of his duty and in the said service on or about the 15th March 1781 at a place called Guilford Court-house in the State of North Carolina by a musket ball passing through the shoulder joint of the right shoulder – that s'd Joseph Legan is not only still disabled in consequence of the said injury but in our opinion is entitled to full pay as an invalied pensioner being disabled to a degree amounting to the actual loss of the use of his said arm and that he ought in our opinion to have been originally placed on the invalid pension roll for a total rather than partial disability.
