On this 5th day of October 1821, before me the subscriber a Justice of the Peace for the County of Cumberland & state aforesaid Personally appeared Elisha Hunt (a Coloured Man) who on his oath declares that he is the same person who formerly belonged to the Company commanded by Capt. Benj'n. Coleman [Benjamin Andrew Coleman] in the 2^d regiment Commanded by Col. John Patton [sic: John Patten] in the Service of the United States that his name was placed on the Pension roll of the State of N. Carolina in consequence of the loss of his right arm at the Siege of Charleston S.C. [29 Mar - 12 May 1780] by a Certificate obtained from Col. Nicholas Long & Doct. Charles Pastures of Halifax District N.C. (as well as he recollects in the year 1785) which certificate was forwarded by them to the War department Since which time he has drawn his Pension up to the fourth of March one thousand eight hundred & twenty & If ever a certificate was obtained from said department it was filed by the aforesaid named Gentlemen in the Loan [Land?] office of N.C. or lost or mislaid by himself without any recollection whatever of having ever rec'd. one to that effect ~
