State of North Carolina Jones County: SS

Personally appeared before me Christopher Bryan one of the Justices of the Peace for Jones County Hugh Stanly who maketh oath that he has been on the pension list as an invalid Pensioner ever since the Revolutionary War and has always received his pension as such from the pay master or Treasurer for the State, at Raleigh, until the alteration made since the late War he further deposeth and saith that if he ever had a certificate of his being on the pension list, it has been filed in Secretaries office at Raleigh, that he does not recollect of ever having such a certificate in his possession – further this deponent saith not.

Sworn to before made this 28th day of November A.D. 1821
