Answer. The first time I went out, I was a substitute for William Bacom, the other times I was out I was drafted.

Interrogatory 5<sup>th</sup>. State the names of some of the regular officers, who were with the troops where you served, such Continental & Militia Regiments as you can recollect, and the general circumstances of your service.

Answer. I cannot recollect the names of the officers nor the general circumstances of my service, more nor better than I have set out in my declaration.

Interrogatory 6<sup>th</sup>. Did you ever receive a discharge from the service, and if so by whom was it given and what has become of it?

Answer. I received a discharge at one time, but from whom I do not recollect, nor do I know what has become of it.

Interrogatory 7<sup>th</sup>. State the names of some persons to whom you are known in your neighborhood and who can testify to your character for truth and veracity, and their belief of your services as a soldier of the revolution.

Answer. I would refer you to James Ward, James V. White, Robert Meek, James Goodhue, E. G. English Abraham Noakes, and Edward Tucker all of my neighborhood who have known me for a number of years, who can testify to my character for truth and veracity &c.

NOTE: Gen. Nathanael Greene replaced Gen. Horatio Gates as commander of the Southern Army about 2 Dec 1780 at Charlotte NC.
