Pension Application of Charles Lenox S25629

Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[The pension application is missing from the file. Lenox's application to transfer his pension from Pennsylvania to Clarke County, Kentucky, dated 14 Nov 1824, states that he served under Capt. Peyton and Col. Marshall. A pension awarded before 1824 would probably have been for service as a Continental soldier. Col. Marshall was probably Thomas Marshall of the 3rd Virginia Regiment from 21 Feb 1777 - 21 Feb 1778, after which he commanded the State Artillery Regiment. Valentine Peyton was a captain in the 3rd Regiment under Marshall.

A size roll compiled at Chesterfield Courthouse after 1 Sep 1780 lists the following: Charles Lenox/ age 26/ height 5' 8"/ comb m[aker]/ born in Glasgow, Scotland/ residing in Prince William County/ light brown hair/ hazel eyes/ dark complexion/ enlisted 23 Sep 1780 for 18 months.]
