



was promoted to Major on 30 Apr 1778 and to Lieutenant Col. on 8 Sep 1782.

On 25 Jan 1839 Jenkins applied to have his pension transferred to Illinois having moved to Shelby County three months previously. On 25 April 1839 Jenkins applied again for a transfer, giving the following reason for his move: "his daughter & son in law, with whom he had lived for the last fifteen years and who has provided for him, & who he expects will provide & take care of him as long as he lives, have removed to the said State of Illinois & he came to Illinois to live with them." On this application he stated that while in Posey's regiment he was in the company commanded by Capt. Warman – probably Thomas Warman.
